


Timeline for Boundary Leapers 2022

Motivational sessions for all Y11 students

This is a series of 8 motivational sessions open to all Y11 students to support them through the examination period. Streamed live each Wednesday morning for a period of 8 weeks, these **You CAN Do This!** sessions are led by the Dreams2Reality team to provide inspiration and support students' stress management, self-care and direction. The Dreams2Reality team has previously worked with GCSE Pod, PIXL and previously with Boundary Leapers.

Schools can use the sessions with as many Year 11 students as they wish. The scheduling has been planned to match tutor group sessions that are held in many schools, but all sessions can be accessed from the Boundary Leapers website afterwards.

These sessions are not specific to English and Maths and are beneficial to all Y11 students and not limited to those involved in other aspects of Boundary Leapers. All colleagues that register their interest here will receive the links for the live sessions to use with your students.

Easter Revision School NEW funded offer for 2022



Boundary Leapers 2022 offers all Derby schools a series of new live sessions to support English and Maths revision. Grant funding is offered for schools to organise an Easter Revision School for GCSE English and Maths students. Funding (£30 per student up to £2,000 max) is provided as a grant to contribute to staffing and operating costs for those schools willing to organise an Easter Revision School for students with the potential to 'leap a boundary' with this extra push. Live revision sessions, delivered by local Derby teachers/examiners, will be streamed each morning from Tues 19th – Fri 22nd April.

Sessions will cover the key revision priorities identified by teachers for the 2022 English and Maths GCSEs. Each session will focus on particular aspects of these topics that students find most challenging. The teachers leading these sessions will make them applicable to all exam boards.

HAF funding: Schools might also consider taking advantage of the government's new funding arrangements for holiday activities (HAF: Holiday Activities & Food) and combining HAF with their Boundary Leapers' grant to create extra opportunity.
